



DSRA Committee meeting

Follow up from October General Meeting

1. Yellow Sand Banks boat ramp – Dave has spoken to Ian & Cassie. Initial contact with MAST suggested that they can't do upgrades for the benefit of commercial operators. Community support would help. Dave to continue liaising with the Melroses & MAST.
2. Access ways – Council advice echoes advice received from Leigh Sealy.
3. Dolphin Sands Emergency Management Plan (DSEMP), draft distributed to community, few comments received so far.
4. Steve Barrett & Robyn developed a 'works program' re clearing roadside verges and are now organising quotes to forward to Council. Aim is for Council to do 10km of urgent work before summer and DSRA to apply for funding to do another 10km, although it can be difficult to get funding for work that is considered core Council business.
5. Aquifer – Dave spoke to AWA Australian Water Association and was referred to Lance Stapleton who was previously the quality manager for TasWater. Lance is an independent consultant and has knowledge or/access to funding streams. Dave to follow up with Lance on Monday. Would like to be able to graph water quality data, establish baseline & try to correlate with patterns, eg rainfall. Aim is to apply for funding for Lance to do.

Development since the October General Meeting

1. Transfer of Cambria footway from ASIC to GSBC – Mel Kelly was facilitating this process. However, her position has been eradicated due to Council's restructure and she has accepted a redundancy. She has asked Greg Ingham, Council's GM, who will take over this process. Robyn to follow up with GM.
2. Picnic tables – Robyn to follow about re purchasing picnic tables.
3. Successful landscaping seminar held.
4. Sea Spurge at Bagot Point – removed.
5. Living at Nine Mile Beach booklet – Mel Kelly has asked Greg Ingham who will take over this project. Robyn to follow up with GM.

6. Resources available for Air BnBs – TFS children’s ‘showbag’ – moneybox, pencils, sticker, colouring book – Donna to distribute to interested hosts
