Saturday, Jan 23, 2021

Meeting opened: 4pm

- What do we want to achieve this year?

Picnic tables – grant body wants to know how project is progressing

Community engagement activities, eg gardening day, fire safety, Landcare group – rubbish removal, weeding; workshops; car boot sale (spring)

DG to follow up re courses about dry stone walls and chain saw licence

RM to follow up with Parks re weed removal at Bagot Point

- When to hold the AGM? Saturday March 13, 10-12noon

RM – book courthouse; email members; invite guest speakers (10 minutes each + questions) – Marcus Pearce, Marcia Harvey Bird (Bayview Bush Babies), GM

DG – update sign and install in early March

- Emergency messaging – Dave Cooper sent alert during recent bushfire. Need to have more people able to send messages in case Dave or Robyn aren't available. Dave to join DB & DG
- Bushfire – DG to draft letter of thanks to Matt Low – TFS District Officer, SES (RM to forward contact details), Parks; RM write article for local paper & upload to website, Facebook post – consider volunteering; lessons learned

Thank you BBQ for volunteers – TFS, SES, ambos – & recruitment drive – to coincide with Neighbour Day (Sunday, March 28)? RM to check availability of TFS, SES, ambos

- Aquifer update – DG trying to access funding to monitor aquifer. Public Health – no luck; uni – honours thesis – DG to follow up; Community Small Grant?

- Website – RM has updated; due to wix policy, existing pages cannot be updated. These pages have been archived and new pages created
- Picnic tables – agreement with Greg Ingham, Council’s General Manager, in December to supply & install picnic tables on Council land near corner of Cambria Drive and Dolphin Sands Road. Total cost ~\$2500. GM how looking at alternate sites – beach access at ~5km and/or Bagot Point

Email from Healthy Tasmania re grant funding; left over funds??? RM to ask if we can spend up to \$500 of grant funds on community BBQ

- Transfer of land from ASIC to Council – ongoing email discussion with Greg Ingham
- Roadside clearing – email (Nov 2020) from Bev Allen (Council’s Emergency Management Coordinator) saying that Council has a contractor who will undertake works in the new year. This was confirmed during a Nov 2020 meeting with Greg Ingham, Dave Cooper & Robyn Moore. Greg stated that Campbell Low was the relevant contractor. RM to follow-up at end of January if no action
- Neighbour Day – Sunday, March 28 – BBQ with local volunteer groups – BYO drinks, venue TBA, raffle, Neville, Danae & Donna or organise
- Clean Up Australia Day – Sunday, March 7 – RM to ask Gary if he’s interested in co-ordinating
- Speeding at BP – options include more signs, raising speed limit to 60, install ‘low speed limit ahead’ sign. RM to add to agenda for general meeting
- Membership drive – about 100 financial members. Committee members to be excluded from Bunnings prize drawer. Process for prize drawer: financial member listed in alphabetical order and numbered sequentially. Use computer-generated random numbers to select winners
- Bagot Point – Ongoing discussion with Parks re walking track to beach, cultural heritage plaque and weed management. Plaque wasn’t attached to plinth and has been stored for safe keeping. Parks have invited community suggestions for new location at Bagot Point for the plaque. RM to add to agenda for general meeting. RM to register DSRA as a volunteering group with Parks to remove rubbish and weeds from Bagot Point on an ongoing basis
- Dave Cooper not standing for re-election. DC to handover to DG – Yellow Sand Banks boat ramp and progress with Lance Stapleton re aquifer
- Living at Nine Mile Beach booklet – on hold for now

Treasurer’s report – Balance about \$20 000, much of which is ‘earmarked’ for particular projects. Lots of money coming in from membership fees. Made ~\$75 from landscaping seminar and ~\$150 from water testing
