



## DSRA Committee meeting

Monday, Nov 8, 2021

Meeting opened: 7pm

David opened the meeting and acknowledged the traditional owners of the land

1. Security – investigating getting number plate recognition (NPR) camera which would be used by police if there's an incident that police want to follow up. Also signage.  
–takes photo of whole car, with clear image of number plate. Position/angle important for good image.  
Specialist number plate camera about \$1300; would need 2 cameras; also need access to hard drive (\$200-\$300) which could store 2-3 weeks of data. Hard drive would need to be wired – need power to the pole.  
David discussed with Sergeant Tony Peters – v supportive; suggested apply to the Police Community Fund for some funds.  
Could have working group to investigate options, organise fundraising, consider how to protect from vandalism
